To Whom it May Concern:

Uber Canada is licensed as a Transportation Network Company (“TNC”) under Halifax Regional Municipality’s Taxi, Limousine and Transportation Network Companies By-law Number T-1000 (the “Bylaw”).

Halifax Regional Municipality’s Bylaw requires each TNC driver obtain an *annual Vulnerable Sector Check*. TNCs like Uber are required to validate that each driver has completed this check each year. The relevant Bylaw section is reproduced on the following page of this letter.

The Vulnerable Sector criminal record check is an obligation imposed upon all TNC drivers by Halifax Regional Municipality. For this reason, we respectfully request that you conduct the required Vulnerable Sector record check for the prospective TNC driver identified above.

43.0 K TNC DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

43.1 K A Transportation Network Company shall ensure that a person approved as a TNC Driver meets the following requirements at all times when providing transportation services using a TNC Vehicle: ...

- (c) has provided to the TNC original documents from the issuing agency, ***dated within 30 days of approval to be a TNC Driver and then annually thereafter***, outlining acceptable results of investigations related to the applicant for:
 - (i) a criminal record check;
 - (ii) ***a vulnerable sector check*** and
 - (iii) a child abuse registry check;
